Non-food contact surfaces shall be kept clean and free of an accumulation of dust, dirt, food residue, and other debris.</p>
<p>Violation #51. Plumbing installed; proper backflow devices</p> <p>-Repair the constant running water, with faucet locked, located in the rinse sink.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5)(c). Plumbing will be installed and maintained to comply with plumbing requirements, including backflow prevention devices. A mop sink will be provided.</p>
<p>Violation #55. Facilities installed, maintained, &amp; clean</p> <p>-Clean and sanitize ceiling and wall in dry storage #100D. Black stains were observed.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Exterior areas shall be kept cleaned.</p>
<p>Violation #56. Ventilation &amp; lighting</p> <p>-Provide missing light fixture cover in dry storage room #100D. (Repeated)</p> <p>-Clean and sanitize dust accumulation in the milk-box refrigeration #2. Corrected on site (COS)</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.</p>
